

During an accompanied test drive, visitors can experience the vehicle for themselves, arousing emotions that will be remembered forever. You will receive qualified contacts and direct feedback on your products.

The IAA shuttle bus connects the individual exhibition halls during the entire duration of the IAA in a round trip, and can be used by exhibitors and visitors free of charge. Use your vehicles on this route and enhance the experience factor and visibility of your vehicles and brand.

Booking & options IAA test drives for buses

>>> Step 1: Booking an outdoor parking area

To participate in the test drives, the required outdoor parking area (length x width in meters*) for your buses participating in this must be booked close to the bus area (hall 23) using the registration form.

Step 2: Selecting the test route

You decide which of the following test routes you would like to use:

- **2.1 Indoor "City Lane"** through the bus area (hall 23): Your bus will drive through the hall on the defined lane at specific times (several times per day). Special areas along the lane provide opportunities to interact for example with the charging infrastructure.
- **2.2 Outdoor test route** in the east of the exhibition grounds: Here, prototypes without road approval (insurance cover is required) can also be demonstrated along a length of approx. 2 km.
- **2.3** On public roads with area exits via gate Süd 1: Whether it's a tour into downtown, in the countryside or on the motorway you will decide yourself about the route and duration of your individual test drive (road approval and insurance cover are required).

>>> Step 3: Area assignment and additional orders

Once the registration deadline has passed, we will assign you the specific parking area and you will receive access to the exhibitor shop, where you can independently book any required additional services (e.g. power connection for your own wall box/charging column, night watch etc.) at your own cost.



Booking & options Independent driving on the "City Lane"

With the "City Lane", we are integrating an indoor real-world laboratory for independently driving buses amid the bus area.

The marked-off lane leads across hall 23 and provides test versions of different traffic situations:

- Bidirectional driving
- Approaching of stops
- Reading traffic lights and traffic signs
- Pedestrian crossing (zebra crossing)
- Areas for presentation of charging infrastructure solutions.







Let myclimate calculate the CO₂ footprint of your appearance at the IAA and make an investment in climate protection projects equal to the calculated amount of your CO₂ emissions afterwards. As the leading international platform for transport and logistics, the IAA TRANSPORTATION is aware of its responsibility and is moving forward on the topic of climate protection.





Deadline: This application must be received along with the standard registration by August 23, 2024.

The IAA TRANSPORTATION offers all exhibitors the following options and steps:

Step 1: Balance your CO2 footprint and receive the myclimate impact label

- 1.1 Balance the impact of your appearance at the IAA in tons of CO₂ with a subsequent investment in myclimate climate protection projects: 179.00 €*
- 1.2 Have a previous CO₂ calculation, performed with a method based on the GHG (greenhouse gas) protocol, audited by myclimate for your appearance at the IAA and subsequently make an investment in climate protection projects offered by other providers (e.g., Gold Standard, Plan Vivo): 279.00 €*

Step 2: Make an investment in climate protection projects equal to the calculated account of your CO₂ emissions

2.1 Investment in all the following climate protection projects from myclimate:

Togo:

- In Sub-Saharan Africa, 14.5% of total energy consumption is attributable to the transport sector. This sector accounts for 28% of the continent's total emissions and is the second greatest source of CO₂ emissions.
- A total of 9 million e-motorbikes (2-wheel and 3-wheel motorbikes) are distributed in various African countries as part of this project, which also supports the construction of facilities such as exchange and charging stations.

Agroforestry:

This regional climate protection program for agroforestry offers funding for the planting and maintenance of trees on agricultural land areas in Switzerland, Germany, Austria and Liechtenstein. The agroforestry systems remove CO₂ from the atmosphere and provide valuable habitats for a wide range of animal species.

India:

The project will involve building biogas plants in more than 9,000 suitable rural households. Apart from the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions and decreased forest destruction, the population benefits from higher agricultural yields and less health-endangering smoke pollution in their homes. In addition, the project reduces methane emissions due to cattle dung.

Regional project:

- Investments will be made in a new project involving moors in Germany within the near future. We will be publishing more information on this subject soon.
- 2.2 Investment in climate protection projects of other organizations/own projects

As long as investments are made in other climate protection projects, these projects must, without exception, conform to the Gold Standard or the Plan Vivo Standard.
